Pre-dissolve **MASTER MHW** at the rate of 1 to 2 oz per gallon of water. Use hot or warm water if available.

MASTER MHW will not harm concrete, plastic, poly, rubber, glass, paintwork, stainless steel, iron or soft metals such as aluminum when used as directed.
